

- Opportunity Name: Richard H. Thornton Library Teen Book Club Facilitator
- **Hours:** As the Teen Book Club Facilitator, the volunteer would need to commit to facilitating a monthly (or bi-monthly) book club meeting. Hours and preferred day of the week can be discussed with the Children's Librarian. Required volunteer timeframe will need to include set-up, the book club meeting, and clean-up.

## Responsibilities:

- Lead a monthly (or bi-monthly) book club for 4-12 attendees, depending on the volunteer's comfort level.
- Curate a list of books and/or genres that interest the group. The facilitator will work closely with the Children's Librarian to ensure the books arrive in a timely manner so that book club members have time to pick up the book and read it before the next meeting.
- Responsible for creating questions and guiding the conversation around that month's book as well as creating a welcoming experience to all book club members. The volunteer is responsible for facilitating a meeting in which all members feel safe to be themselves.
- Spend adequate time reading the book(s) and preparing for each book club meeting, including prepping a list of questions to ask and/or conversation starters.
- o Communicate regularly, efficiently, and directly with the Children's Librarian regarding the program's preparation and progress after each meeting.
- Qualifications: Strong verbal communication skills a must and previous experience leading a book club a plus. Organized with good time management skills. Desire to develop leadership skills. Applicants should be punctual, dependable, cooperative, and flexible. Welcoming to new attendees. Able to communicate clearly in a tactful, courteous, and pleasant manner with library staff, teens, and parents. Neat appearance.
- As Volunteers: You will acquire new skills and gain recognized work and leadership experience. Expand your social horizons and help build a literate community.
